Former Ambassador to Kenya and permanent representative to the United Nations for Environment and Habitat, former CEO of the Bogota Chamber of Commerce and of the Bogota Energy Group, having duties, among others,

related to operational and enterprise risk management and former District Secretary of Economic Development of Bogotá.

She represented the President of the Republic before the National Television Commission. She has also held the positions of Presidential Advisor for international affairs, Minister of Justice of Colombia, Vice Minister of Justice of Colombia, and Secretary General at the Ministry of Mines and Energy. In addition to her positions in the public sector she also served as Vice-President of Legal and Public Affairs at Shell Colombia Inc, performing, among others, functions related to legal risk assessment.

She was a member of the board of the International Chamber of Commerce of Paris, Promigas S.A., Corporación de Ferias y Exposiciones S.A., Grupo Keralty S.A.S and Gran Colombia Gold. She is currently a member of the Boards of Directors of EPS Sanitas S.A.S., Lagos de Aurea S.A.S, the Aris Mining Corporation, located in Canada, and One Young World, located in London. Also member of the board of Fiducoldex.

Given her professional background, she has expertise in i) the energy industry and energy transition, mainly acquired from her role as Secretary General at the Ministry of Mines and Energy; ii) administration, senior management, and leadership; iii) government affairs and/or public policy; iv) business risk management; v) human resources and talent development; vi) legal affairs and corporate governance; vii) health, safety and/or environment; viii) sustainability; ix) climate change; and x) business strategy and project management.

As a member of Ecopetrol's Board of Directors, she is periodically trained in ethics, compliance, and risk management matters.
